

Directions to Episcopal House, 31 Mulberry St., Newark

From New Jersey Turnpike - North or South - Turnpike exit 15W (or 15E) to Route 280 West. Drive approximately two miles to Exit 15, marked "Route 21/Newark". At this exit, jug handle onto Route 21/McCarter Highway south (toward NJPAC, New Jersey Performing Arts Center) - continue south on 21 until you come to the NJPAC on your right - turn right onto Center Street - make the first left onto Mulberry Street. Episcopal House will be on the left side of the street. Parking is available.

From Garden State Parkway - North or South - Follow GSP to exit 145 - follow signs to Route 280 East (Harrison/Newark) - take exit 15 for Route 21/McCarter Highway south - continue south on 21 until you come to the NJPAC on your right - turn right onto Center Street - make the first left onto Mulberry Street. Episcopal House will be on the left side of the street. Parking is available.

From Route 280 East Bound - Take exit 15 for Route 21/McCarter Highway south - continue south on 21 until you come to the NJPAC on your right - turn right onto Center Street - make the first left onto Mulberry Street. Episcopal House will be on the left side of the street. Parking is available.

You can also follow the public transportation directions provided for NJPAC.

Directions to St. Andrew & Holy Communion, 160 W. South Orange Ave., S. Orange

From Route 280 West-Take Exit 10, marked W. Orange, S. Orange, Montclair — this is also Northfield Ave. - stay to the left. At the top of the exit there is a traffic light, make a left onto Northfield Ave. Go to the third light and make a left onto Gregory Ave. Gregory Ave. becomes Wyoming Avenue. Continue to the end of the road. At the light, make a left onto South Orange Ave. Stay to the right and go down the hill to the next light (this is Ridgewood Road). The Church is on your right just past the next traffic light. Go past the Church and turn right onto Church Street. Church parking to the right, Municipal lot (free) to the left.


From Route 280 East - Take Exit 8A, marked Prospect Ave., West Orange. Stay on Prospect Ave. Prospect Ave. ends at Northfield Ave. Make a left onto Northfield Avenue and stay to the right. Go down the hill to the next traffic light and make a right onto Gregory Avenue. Follow the directions above from Gregory Ave.

From Route 24 East and Route 78 East (local exits) - Take Exit 49B, marked Millburn/Maplewood. This is Springfield Avenue. Go over Route 24, and stay to the left past 'The Home Depot' and 'The Crescent Golf Range' to Vauxhall Road (at an intersection with 3 gas stations). Make a left onto Vauxhall Road. Just before the next traffic light is a sign marked 'Seton Hall, 3 miles', and just beyond that sign is a right traffic feeder that takes you onto Valley Street. Make that right and continue on Valley Street to South Orange Avenue (7 traffic lights). Turn left onto South Orange Avenue. Go down the hill, and under the railroad overpass. Go through the next traffic light (which is an entry to the New Jersey Transit parking lot) and make the first left you can onto Church Street (which is just before the next traffic light at Ridgewood Road). Church parking to the right, Municipal lot (free) to the left.

He is a gifted storyteller and has a penchant for mischievously confronting listeners with new insights that are both affirming and liberating.
