What: **"Undoing Racism"** 2 ½- day introductory workshop retreat, instructed by *The Peoples Institute for Survival and Beyond*, and assisted by members of the Diocesan Anti-Racism Commission/Team. The workshop's systemic approach emphasizes understanding racism, learning from history, developing leadership, maintaining accountability to communities, undoing internalized racial oppression, and understanding the role of organizational gate keeping as a mechanism to perpetuate institutional racism.

When: **April 7-9, 2016**
The workshop is a residential retreat, beginning with dinner at 6:00 PM on Thursday followed by training until 9 PM. Instruction begins after breakfast (provided) at 8:30 AM on Friday and Saturday, and ends on Saturday at 4:00 PM.
