

ONLINE REGISTRATIONS FOR CLERGY CONFERENCE 2015 BEGIN NOW!

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Friday, September 18th

ALL CLERGY: Please follow this link (http://www.dioceseofnewark.org/form/registration-clergy-conference-2015) to register for the 2015 Clergy Conference. While at the conference, you will welcome our keynote speaker, the Most Rev. Katharine Jefferts Schori and spend time communing with fellow clergy, Mother Nature and yourself! Please note that the opening session with our speaker will once again begin at 4:00pm on Monday, Oct. 26 so please plan your travel accordingly. And bring your dancin' shoes!! Tuesday night after dinner, Chuck Hatfield's classic rock band Walkin' the Boulevard will be playing an extended set of songs from the 60's, 70's and 80's (emphasis on the 70's!) for your dancing and listening pleasure!!

THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS **SEPTEMBER 18** SO PLEASE ACT QUICKLY

Please note:

- 1. ONLINE REGISTRATIONS FOR CLERGY CONFERENCE 2015 BEGIN NOW! As always, all clergy are respectfully expected to attend the Conference and all attendees must submit a diocesan registration form.
- 2. OVERNIGHT ATTENDEES: All clergy staying at the Shawnee Inn will once again make their own room reservations directly with the Inn (1-800-SHAWNEE). Please tell the clerk that you are with "the Episcopal Diocese of Newark" in order to receive the group rate. (Best not to register through a discount website the fee is the fee no matter what! Please contact the hotel directly.) As usual, your payment at check-out on Wednesday covers hotel accommodations and your meals so if you're registered at the Inn, there's no need to pay the fee for commuter meals.



- REMEMBER! You must call the Shawnee and make your own room reservation. If you plan to stay at the hotel, pick up the phone and call the Inn RIGHT NOW! 1-800-SHAWNEE. You'll be glad you did © Deadline is Friday, September 18th. Note that checks are not accepted at check-out (see #6).
- 4. IMPORTANT NOTE: Once again, your conference package rates are substantially subsidized, with the following results:

Single occupancy: contract price for 2 nights is \$433.00 per person; you pay \$265
Double occupancy: contract price for 2 nights is \$299.00 per person; you pay \$190*
Commuter Package: contract price for 6 meals is \$165 per person; you pay \$115
*As in the past, if you are sharing a room, please inform the clerk when you make your reservation. Also, please note that if a double room suddenly becomes a single room, the remaining occupant will be charged the single occupancy rate. Please contact Kay Lark if this occurs. Also note that no package can be adjusted, shared, reduced or split.

- 5. For those of you who require further financial assistance, limited scholarship support will once again be available. Please send Kay Lark an email at klark@dioceseofnewark.org for details.
- 6. Clergy who wish to pay their hotel bill by check should mail said check to The Shawnee Inn, ATTN: Group Sales, P.O. Box 67, Shawnee-on-Delaware, PA 18356 postmarked by September 18th. Please include a note with name, dates, etc. In this scenario, you'll pay the basic fee (see above) with the check, then settle up any additional charges (bar, etc.) with cash or a credit card when you check out on Wednesday. Also please drop me an email that you have paid by check and in what amount. Thanks!
- 7. Clergy who give a **debit card** number to the hotel: as explained to me twice, when a debit card is given to the hotel, even to hold for additional charges (bar, etc.) which may or may not materialize, YOUR BANK (not the hotel) puts a hold on funds to cover potential hotel charges. Please take this into account when deciding which card to give the hotel as unintentional overdrafts could occur.
- 8. COMMUTING ATTENDEES: For those who are not staying overnight at the Inn but desire to join colleagues for the six meals included in the Commuter meal plan, you'll see payment instructions on the diocesan registration page [please pay online (preferred) or via a check mailed to me postmarked by Monday, September 18th]. No outside food is allowed into the Hotel.
- 9. Due to the subsidy of registrations fees this year, I need to receive your registrations pronto!! The <u>deadline of **September 18**th</u> is necessary as I must calculate and send a check to the Inn and they must then apply the funds to each and every registration, all before we arrive. This will obviously take time so please put your diocesan registration (AND hotel reservations or commuter payments) at the top of your To-Do List!
- 10. ANOTHER IMPORTANT NOTE: After you have reviewed your registration information on the online form, please be sure to press the "Submit" button because this action will complete your registration and will also trigger an email to be sent to THE EMAIL ADDRESS YOU ENTERED ON THE FORM. If you enter a little-used email address, please know to check that address for your confirmation email.
- 11. Need a roommate? Don't just write it on the registration form this will likely have no result! Send a clergy-all email! Call someone!
- 12. Just another quick reminder that the traffic volume can really build up on I-80 near the river so please arrive early and enjoy the tranquility of the Inn instead!! War stories abound (weather, accidents, etc.) please leave yourself plenty of time!

13. Hotel Information:

- All guests must check in at the Front Desk, even if sharing a room
- Our check-in begins officially at 4pm on Monday (some rooms will be available earlier than that and they will check bags if necessary); check out on Wednesday is 11am <u>PLEASE NOTE</u> AS LATE CHECK-OUTS INCUR A \$50 FEE TO YOU! I checked again this year! No kidding!
- Please note that the Shawnee is a NON-SMOKING facility (with a smoking area on the Front Veranda)
- For those new to the Inn, the Delaware Lodge is located on the Inn property, a brisk walk or short drive down the driveway. Rooms in the Inn are allocated first unless the Lodge is requested.
- There is wi-fi throughout the Inn, including the Delaware Lodge
- Please be aware that a dearth of cellphone towers and the sturdy structure of the Inn combine to make cellphone reception iffy in certain locations. Please make sure those at home have the 1-800-SHAWNEE number to call if they need you and can't reach you by phone.
- All local phone calls from your room are at no cost
- Again, no beverages or food of any kind will be permitted to be brought into the hotel (i.e. no bag lunches, etc.)
