SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2018

General:

1. Location- NJ Performing Arts Center, One Center St., Newark, NJ
2. Doors to lobbies open at 9:15 AM; doors to theatre open at 9:45 AM. Please be seated by 10:30 AM.
3. Parking - max cost is approximately \$20 for event parking
 - a. Area Lots include:
 - b. NJPAC Lot A (on premises) and Lot C (14-38 Mulberry St)
 - c. Military Park Garage - underground parking, 42-50 Park Pl
 - d. There is NO parking available at the Diocese (31 Mulberry Street)
 - e. Please read street signs carefully if you use street parking.
 - f. Carpooling is encouraged, as is mass transit.
4. Tickets - No one can enter NJPAC without a ticket or pass for the Consecration. Tickets are free and must be obtained in advance.
5. Wear Red! - Red is the color of the Holy Spirit, and we know she is at work in our Diocese.
6. Childcare - we are not able to offer childcare during the service.
7. Communion – Please follow the Ushers! Those needing communion brought to them should inform an usher. Consecrated Grape juice and Gluten-free wafers are available on each tier. An usher will direct you.
8. Solutions Desk - we have a solutions desk to help you with your needs.
9. Water - there are drinking fountains at NJPAC and 24 Rector Street.
10. Offering: checks made payable to the Diocese of Newark. The offering will go to the Alleluia Fund
11. Hearing assisted devices are available at NJPAC. Come to the solutions desks for assistance.
12. **Photos and videos:** There will be three professional photographers, and NJPAC's professional team will be capturing video using multiple cameras, so there will be ample professional coverage of this event. If you do take your own photos or videos, please follow these three rules: 1) NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY; 2) always be quiet and unobtrusive (remember this a religious service); do not get in the way of the professionals, or block their line of sight (they may be behind you). Civic leaders/Executive Council Members/Provincial Officers/ Standing Committee/Diocesan Council/Diocesan Trustees/Diocesan Staff/Diocesan Youth reps and leaders/Search and Nominating Committee/Transition Committee will gather in the Chase Room, lobby second level, near Nico Restaurant. Street clothes and hopefully wear something red for celebration!

Minister of Ceremonies/Chaplain to the incoming Bishop/Presenters of the Bishop-Elect/Readers of Testimonials (episcopal/clerical/academic garb as appropriate)/Registrar/Presenters of Gifts/Litanist/Old Testament Readers/New Testament Readers/Ministers of Communion will enter through the Stage Entrance on the back of the NJPAC and gather in the Performers' Lounge just off the Security Lobby. Street clothes and something red (hopefully) unless otherwise noted.

Deacon Formation Candidates (street clothes)/Seminarists (street clothes)/Seminary Deans (academic garb please)/Ecumenical and Interfaith Clergy/Clergy of the Diocese/Visiting Episcopal Clergy/Bishop-Elect will gather at 24 Rector Street and process through the Stage Entrance into the theatre. Clerical garb unless otherwise noted. The color is red.

Gospeller/Deacons of the Table/Episcopal, Lutheran and Moravian Bishops/Diocesan Banner/Preacher/Co-Consecrating Bishops/Chaplain to the Retiring Bishop/Retiring Bishop/Canon to the Presiding Bishop/Presiding Bishop will gather in or near the Parsonnet Room, lobby second level, near Nico Restaurant.

Choir Members:

1. Beginning at 7:00am, you will enter through the Victoria Theatre lobby, sign in and receive your backstage pass – you must be on the list to sing.
2. Bring with you original copies of the music and choir robes as available.
3. Be onstage and ready to sing at 8 AM on Saturday, September 22.
4. The rehearsals will last till 9:45 AM; however, not every ensemble will rehearse the entire time to allow for breaks.
5. Water Bottles and snacks- please bring water and any snacks you may need with you.
6. IMPORTANT NOTES: You will be sitting in the Victoria Theatre itself before going onstage to rehearse and we must keep food and other trash off the floor. We cannot guarantee the safety of belongings left in this space but we will do our utmost. Leave extraneous valuables at home!

Instrumental Musicians:

1. You will be given parking instructions.
2. Enter Stage Entrance then proceed to the Victoria Lobby entrance to receive backstage pass, all any time after 7am
3. Bagpipes will gather and warm up in the Green Room.
4. Other musicians will “greenroom” in Dressing Room #2 (and the Victoria Theatre Lounge, immediately adjacent to the Security office if you need more space). We cannot

guarantee the safety of belongings left in these spaces but we will do our utmost. Leave extraneous valuables at home!

5. Mark Trautman will provide rehearsal times for Sat. morning.
6. Doors to the lobbies open at 9:15am; theatre open 9:45am, procession begins 10:45, service begins 11am

Dancers

1. Arrival time will be established by group leader
2. You will enter through the Stage Entrance on the back of NJPAC.
3. You will be in a dressing room backstage – we will direct you.
4. We cannot guarantee the safety of belongings left in this space but we will do our utmost. Leave extraneous valuables at home!

Ushers

1. You must have a ticket to sit in a seat at NJPAC.
2. Arrive at 24 Rector Street to meet Gail Barkley at 9 AM on Saturday.
3. Wear something red!

Banner Bearers

1. You must have a ticket to enter NJPAC. You will enter through the Victoria Theatre entrance on the front of the building and gather in that lobby no later than 10 AM with banner, stand, and pole in hand. Your stand needs to be clearly marked with church's name and TOWN.
2. The Banner coordinators will show you where in the second floor lobby you will take your banner after processing at the beginning of the service. You will pre-set your stand in this area for post-procession display.
3. You will sit with your congregation or wherever you choose after you have placed your banner in the lobby.
4. You are responsible for retrieving and removing your banner, stand and pole after the service.

All other groups/Standing Committee/Staff/ Trustees, Transition/ Youth/ Seminarians/Candidates/Standing Committee, etc. who are in the procession will gather in the following spaces by 10 AM latest.

Clergy- not part of communion distribution

1. Arrival time is to be present by 10 AM sharp at 24 Rector Street
2. You will process as a group into the service
3. Clergy NOT participating in the altar party or distributing communion vest in cassock, surplice, and red stole
4. Your guests will sit in the general seating area.
5. Keep valuables to a minimum, please. There will be security at 24 Rector Street.

Clergy walking with another group (such as Trustees, Transition, Standing Committee, or other group or council) please vest at 24 Rector if necessary then gather in your stated location.
