Questions for Sharing Time in Faith Groups

The most fundamental question for sharing is “How did you experience God at work since we last met?”

There is no reason a Faith Group can’t always use this question or something similar. In these groups we are sharing about God and Me. . . .God and my Life, my family. . .and so on!

Here are some other suggested questions that can be used (some of these questions may be better for a faith group that has been meeting for a while)¹:

How have you experienced the unconditional love of God? What does that love feel like?

Share an experience that taught you something about the power of Jesus?

Jesus commands us to love our neighbor, share a story of a time you found that particularly difficult? How did you respond?

Share a story about a time you allowed God to change your mind?

Share a story about an experience of abundance? Where was God in that experience? How did you show/express gratitude?

How did you remain open to God this week?

Share a story about a time you saw God in someone who was treated very different from yourself (or a person that has probably had a very different life experience than you)? How did that change you?
