Who was David P. Hegg II?

Advocate and advisor to seniors and congregations on issues related to aging

- Long-time parish priest
- Rector of St. Peter's Morristown: 1982-1996
- Senior V-P Church Pension Fund and Director of Pastoral Care and Education



Who are the honorees?

- *Active members of the parish*
- *Age 60 and over*
- *Made or are still making contributions to the congregation or diocese*



How are honorees chosen?

- *On-line announcement is sent to clergy and wardens approximately two months before the event*
- *Clergy/wardens seek input from key leaders and/or congregation*
- *Name(s) of honorees are submitted using on-line process (maximum of two per parish)*



What else has to be done?

- *Write a brief bio sketch describing the honoree's contributions to the diocese and/or congregation*
- *Complete the online submission form and include the bio sketch*
- *Submit completed materials according to directions*



Is there a cost?

- *Suggested donation of \$25.00 (covers administrative expenses)*
- *Make check payable to “Diocese of Newark” with Hegg Award in the memo line*
- *Send check to Diocese of Newark,
31 Mulberry St., Newark, 07102-5202*



How is the award given?

- *At an Evensong service in May or June*
- *Presented to the honoree by the Bishop*
- *Service begins at 4:00 PM*
- *Service is preceded by a reception at the host church, beginning at 3:00 PM*
