- the <u>Jonathon Daniels Memorial</u> in Hayneville;
- the Edmund Pettis Bridge in Selma, the site of <u>Bloody Sunday</u> in 1965, which spurred the passage of the Voting Rights Act later that year. St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Selma for Sunday Service
